

Guidelines and Recommendations for the MGA Handicap Committee

1. The purpose of the handicap committee is to monitor and oversee the handicaps of all MGA Members.
2. The Goal of the Handicap Committee (Committee) is to create an environment where all MGA members have an equitable means of competing.
3. Duties of the Handicap Committee will consist of insuring all MGA members who play in MGA tournaments that their scores are recorded and posted as tournaments in “stroke play” events ***and all other tournaments which the round is completed. Therefore it will be part of the rules of each tournament such as a “Best Ball” that players picking up prior to the hole being finished will record a the score most likely to of occurred.***
4. At all MGA tournaments, all members will be requested to post their scores for that tournament.
5. Committee will check to insure posting are made and made correctly.
i.e. Correct score and posted as a tournament.
6. ***Committee will post a member’s correct score if not done so by member .***
7. Committee will report to the MGA board any irregularities that it may find in a member’s posting for further action by the Board if necessary.

Rules for Recording Scores in all MGA Events

1. The goal of the MGA is to insure all players compete in as equitable field as possible
2. It is a Rule of the MGA that all players competing in a MGA event will have their scores posted and posted as tournaments.
3. Those recording the scores for players shall record a complete score for all players, i.e. no X or – permitted.
4. If a player chooses not to complete the hole the player and scorer will agree and record the score most likely to have occurred.
