

## Guidelines and Recommendations for the MGA Handicap Committee

1. The Goal of the Handicap Committee (“the Committee”) is to create an environment where all MGA members have an equitable means of competing. The purpose of the Committee is to monitor, oversee and where required adjust the handicaps of all MGA Members in accordance with the procedures established by the USGA for Tournament Scoring in their publication “The USGA Handicap System”.
2. The Committee will consist of a minimum of four and no more than six MGA Board members and Golf staff. If available these would be the MGA President, Tournament Chairman, Handicap Chairman, Assistant Handicap Chairman and Head Golf Professional.
3. The duties of the Committee will consist of insuring all MGA members and MGA tournament participants that their scores are recorded and posted in the Trophy Club handicap system as “tournament” scores. ..
4. Scorecards returned with illegible or missing scores on a particular hole will default to a score of Bogey being recorded by the Committee.
5. At all MGA tournaments, all participants scores will be posted by the Committee / Pro Shop in the Trophy Club handicap system as “tournament” scores.
6. The Committee will check to insure that tournament scores are posted correctly.
7. The Committee will post their rules, guidelines and procedures on the Trophy Club MGA website for all members to review.
